What specific responsibilities do members of this team have?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Setting up all the elements needed for the service and cleaning up and resetting the altar for the second service. • Making sure communion napkins and cloths are picked up and laundered and then stored in the appropriate location. • The Communion Steward is also responsible for training other individuals to set up Communion in his/her absence. • The Communion Steward must communicate with the Pastors for any changes or special services coming up.
